

Ball

Difficulty: **

Preparation: *

First, train yourself to make an undetectable false drop (see video).

- 1- The ball in the right hand passes into the left hand with a "clap" from the right hand to the left hand.*
- 2- Bring the ball back inside the right hand with the middle and ring fingers while keeping the index finger extended.*
- 3- Close your fingers on the left hand while wrapping the index finger on the right hand.*
- 4- Remove your index finger from the closed left hand.*
- 5- Move the right hand away from the left hand while keeping the index finger extended.*

Break down these movements slowly and then gradually accelerate. This trick can be performed in front of an audience only if you have acquired a perfect movement fluidity.

Performing a trick without having a perfect technique can discourage you.

Prepare a clear glass and a paper towel.

Grasp the Ball in your right hand, make a false drop. Take the paper towel in your right hand and place it around the Ball.

Drop it into the glass.

Since making the false drop, your left hand has remained closed. Open your left hand and show that the ball has traveled and is in the napkin.

Bubbles

Difficulty: ***

Preparation: *

Now that you have mastered the false drop, we'll move on to the next step.

In the previous round, you became familiar with the Ball. Now you will discover one of the many possibilities of these two balls.

Ask the audience to open their hand and leave it open. Make a false drop with your left hand. Grab the other ball with your right hand between your thumb and forefinger. Group Ball and Bubble in the right hand and drop both balls into the spectator's open hand, keeping good pressure so that the balls do not escape until the audience closes their hand.

Ask the audience to close their hand, turning it over so they don't check the contents.

Since the false drop, your left hand has remained closed. Bring it closer to the audience's hands, make a magic pass and ask them to check that the ball or bubbles have travelled in their hand.

This trick requires good coordination and a perfect combination of the different steps, and will take much more practice than the others. Be patient, because this trick, once you are able to perform it, will give you a lot of satisfaction.

Always remember to master the trick before performing it in front of an audience.
